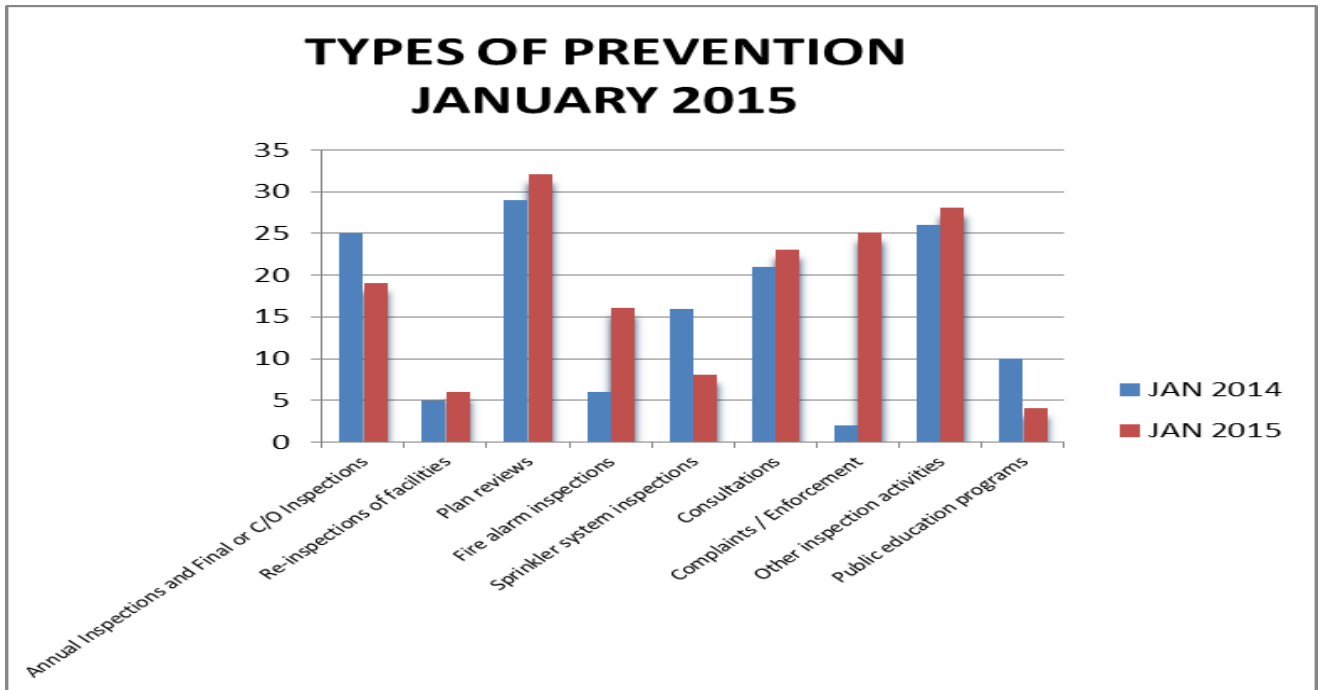


## FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

League City Police Department requested the WFD Dive Team's assistance after an automobile plunged into a waterway. No occupants were recovered either from the submerged vehicle or waterway. Three (3) divers responded to this request. The divers affixed chains to the sunken vehicle, and it was recovered by a tow truck.
