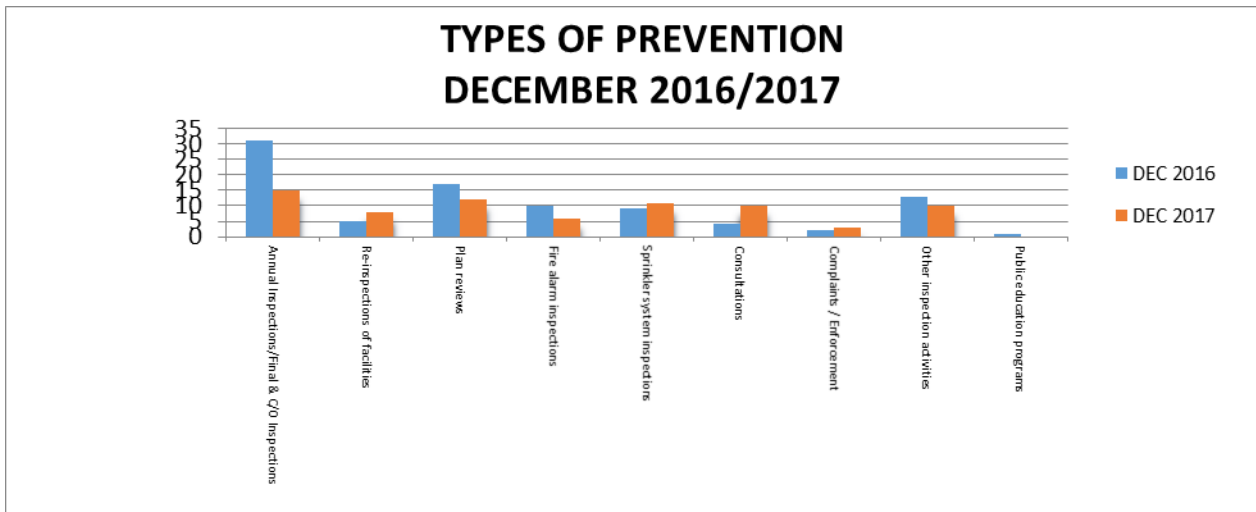


## FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE
